


# Friday 15th March 2024

We were fortunate to have our own private viewing of Sage the Tawny Owl, who was very cute. Some of the pupils' favourite birds included the Secretary Bird (who put on a comical but deadly display attacking a fake python), a Snowy owl called Sweeny Todd, a Crested Caracara, an incredibly fast Lanner Falcon and the graceful White Storks". 


# Outstanding balances on your accounts:
