We found original logs books of the school dating back to October 1899 when a new headteacher, Harriette Hollins, had just taken over running the school. These log books then traverse through time and history, covering two World Wars and come to an end in the 1970s. With these books was also the original punishment book detailing all of the children that have received corporal punishment at the school between 1902 and 1985. It is incredible the history that can be found on these pages.

Sharing them with staff has made all of us keen to incorporate the incredible history of the school and the village into our curriculum. We are currently exploring ways we can do this and hope to have something that can excite the

children about the history of their school and local area through a whole school project in the summer term.

In school this week we have been fortunate enough to have the Christchurch team in working with Beech and Sycamore. The children have also been busy creating their decorations ahead of the Christmas Fair next Friday.

I hope you all enjoy the extended weekend and we look forward to seeing the children again on Tuesday 3rd December.




Rags to Riches Clothing Collection

Workshop for Winchester primary schoolchildren

with Alis Huws – former Official Royal Harpist

Saturday 21st December 2024, at 4.30pm

World-renowned harpist Alis Huws is the former Official Royal Harpist, and last year **performed at His Majesty** King Charles III's Coronation at Westminster Abbey. Still in her twenties, Alis was named on Classic FM's '30 under 30 Rising Stars' list for 2024.

Alis is passionate about outreach and **bringing music into communities**, regularly giving workshops and recitals in schools. Her belief in reaching the wider community is central to her ethos as a performing musician. She recently embarked on a tour of 30 primary schools across Wales, and currently holds a weekly residency at a SEND school.

She will be putting on a 45-minute free workshop for the primary schoolchildren of Winchester, to introduce youngsters to the beauty of the harp.

This event is organised by Southern Voices, to sit alongside their Christmas Concert at 7.30pm the same day, also in the Chapel of St.Cross, at which Alis will also be performing.
