<p>Can you write a list of all of thing you might need when visiting the beach?</p> <p>Lit/PD/PSED</p>	<p>Can you help Sally Seagull to count her shells? She had 10 but 3 get washed away. Use your fingers or objects to work out how many she has left</p> <p>Ma/C+L</p>	<p>Look around your home. Find 2 things that will float and 2 things that will sink in water. Test it out and write down your results.</p> <p>Ma/C+L/U+W</p>
<p>When you're outside, have a look at your shadow. Can you make it bigger or smaller than you? Can you make it disappear?</p> <p>PSED/Ma/C+L</p>	<p>Can you make a boat out of old plastic containers? How many 10p pieces does it take until it sinks?</p> <p>PD/EaD/Ma</p>	<p>Can you make a healthy yoghurt ice cream? Just pop some yoghurt in an ice-lolly mould or in a freezer bag and then enjoy.</p> <p>C+L/PSED</p>
<p>Draw a picture of what you might find in a rock pool!</p> <p>EaD/ PD</p>	<p>Make a seaside in a glass jar. Get a glass jar and some sand. Label what is there- what can you see/ hear/ smell/ taste/ touch?</p> <p>C+L/PD/Lit</p>
