
Year R Sounds of the week:

How you can help at home..

- Year R- Continue to log into bug club- reading both the allocated books and the other books they have to offer.
- Year R- Continue to practise letter formation.
- Year 1: Read our phonics-linked book of the week on Bug Club and notice where you find the sound we learnt last week.
- Play some phonics games (try Phonics Play, Bug Club or other apps) and practise your sounds.
- Year 1: Log into Numbots to practise mental maths skills.
- Year 1: Practise reading the high frequency words in your reading diaries. When you feel you can read them fluently bring them in to be changed for new words.
