### **Year 6 Residential to Calshot Activity Centre – October 2026**

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am delighted to inform you that we have booked our Year 6 Residential to Calshot Activity Centre for Monday 19th to Friday 23rd October 2026.

The focus will be split between activities and fieldwork which are directly linked to the geography curriculum back at school. In addition, our ongoing commitment remains to provide a rich and meaningful experience for our children that promotes perseverance, courage and independence. The children will have the chance to try exciting activities such as kayaking, sailing, climbing, dry slope skiing and velodrome cycling to name a few.

A parents' information evening will be held at the beginning of the autumn term next year.

The total cost of the trip will be £543.10. This is made up of a charge of £515 for board, lodgings and activities and £28.10 for the cost of transport to and from Calshot.

To book a place on this trip, please complete the relevant section at the bottom of this form and return to the school office by **Monday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2026**. A non-refundable deposit of £150 is required by the end of March 2025 to secure your child's place on the Calshot residential. This can either be paid in one amount by 27th March 2026 or in 2 instalments of £75 due on 27th February and 27th March 2026. The final balance of £393.10 would be due by 30th September 2026. Please note that the full cost of the residential is payable even if your child no longer attends the residential.

We are always aware of the cost implications of these visits. During planning and booking we strive for the best value for money. We are committed to ensuring a clear purpose and value to every trip and so we work hard to make sure as many pupils attend as possible, working with parents to remove obstacles to participation whether financial, social or psychological.
