Arrival

- school reception is located in the main entrance to the school
- on arrival you will be asked to sign the visitor's App sign in screen
- you will be given a visitor's lanyard which you will be required to wear at all times whilst on the school premises
- when departing you need to sign out and return your visitor's lanyard

First Aid

- for first aid support please contact the school office or a member of staff
- give concise information about the injury and the location of the injured person
- a trained first-aider will be sent to the scene
- all accidents or 'near-misses' must be reported
- Emergency medical equipment such as inhalers or adrenaline pens are held in the pupils classrooms

Security

- please keep personal belongings and paperwork safe
- Do not leave paperwork with personal details unattended
- do not leave valuables in cars—if this is unavoidable, then please lock valuables out of sight in the boot

Fire Safety

On discovering a fire....

- proceed to the nearest call point and break glass– these are situated at all fire exits
- evacuate the building by the nearest available exit and go to the muster point on the top playground
- report to the duty officer (Head Teacher or representative) stating the type of fire and its location

On hearing the fire alarm

- immediately evacuate the building via the nearest exit
- listen to instructions from the fire wardens
- do not run or panic
- proceed directly to the muster point (located on the top playground)
- report to the duty officer who will check your name against the visitor's register
- <u>DO NOT</u> return to the building until you are instructed to do so

Disabled Visitors

- if you have a disability and feel that you may require assistance during an evacuation of the building, please advise reception staff on signing the visitor's book
- arrangements can then be made to assist you with the evacuation



inform reception or a member of the school staff


- please ensure you keep all packages, briefcases and laptop cases with you at all times
