Our Curriculum this week:

Core Subjects



In English, we are focusing on non-chronological reports (NCR). We will be identifying key features, developing and extending our sentences and even creating our very own river, ready for the following week where we will create our own NCR.

In Maths, we will continue to explore fractions. The year 3s will be comparing and ordering fractions and the year 4s will be introduced to mixed number fractions.

In Reading, we are focusing on retrieving information by scanning and finding the key words in the question and then in the text.

In Science, we are investigating whether all metals are magnetic. The children will come up with their own enquiry to answer the question: are all metals magnetic?

Foundation Subjects

History— We will explore Cleopatra's legacy and examine the differing opinions of her through history

French— We will how to describe our height and eye colour

Computing— We will be learning to use formulae to calculate.
