Our Curriculum this week:

Core Subjects

In writing, we are exploring leaflets, identifying features, comparing texts and looking at persuasive language used.

In maths, we are focusing on converting units - 12- 24 hour, inches to cm etc. We then move on to shapes, symmetry and angles, exploring properties.

In reading, we are focusing on the VIPER skills of vocabulary, reading leaflets to see the ways that they persuade and collecting ideas for our own leaflets.
