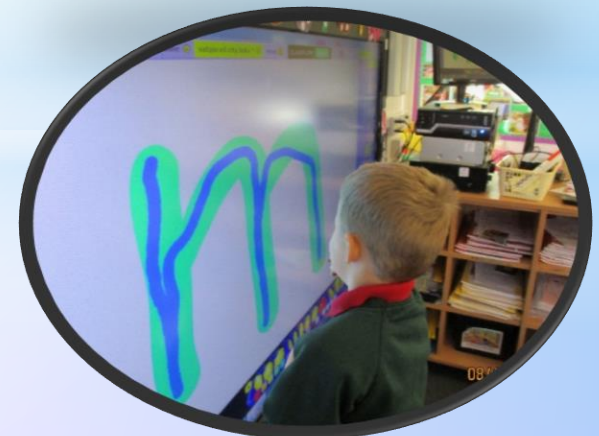
At School

We do lots of interesting and exciting learning activities inside Ash Classroom too....

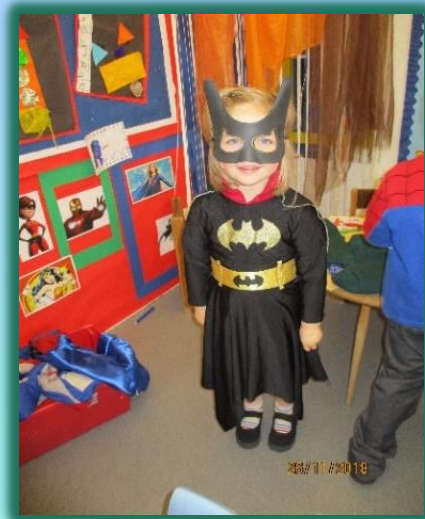




At School
