Dear Parents and Carers,

We are excited to inform you that we have arranged to return to Stubbington Study Centre for the Year 4 children's residential in Spring 2027!

We are able to offer every child the opportunity to go on this wonderful residential experience from Monday 15th - Wednesday 17th March 2027. As well as being lots of fun, the purpose of the trip is for the children to develop their skills in co-operation, teamwork and independence. This trip has an extra special environmental, wildlife theme that all our pupils enjoy, whilst enhancing our Year 4 science curriculum.

The cost of this trip will be approximately £186.92 per child. The price includes all transport, the expert led activity programme costs and full board at Stubbington Study Centre. If you would like to reserve a place for your child on this trip, please log into Scopay and complete the form you will see next to 'Stubbington Year 4 Residential 2027'.

A non-refundable deposit of £50 is due by when confirming your child's place. The deposit and subsequent payments can be made online via Scopay or by cash or cheque (made payable to Hampshire County Council). Places are not able to be reserved for children unless the deposit is received along with the completed form on Scopay by **26th February 2026**. We will confirm the final cost a little closer to the date once final arrangements are in place.

Please note that once the school has received the deposit and form, you are liable to pay the full cost of the trip by 31st January 2027. No refunds will be available for any reason if your child does not subsequently take part in the trip.

A child's place may be withdrawn if the payments for their place are not made on time and the balance cleared by 31st January 2027. We are unable to offer a refund if your child's place is withdrawn. Please contact the school office if you feel you will have difficulty funding this trip.

At the end of the autumn term, we begin supporting the pupils with preparations for the trip and in early Spring 1 we will hold a parents' information evening where you will be able to find out more, including the exciting itinerary for the trip and all the items your child will need to pack.
